**Project Brief**

Monday 24 June is the deadline for the mandatory Project Brief.

This is a one-page document which must include the following:

- Agreed project title
- Your name
- Your supervisor
- Description of your project question/problem
- The goals for your project, what you are trying to achieve
- The scope of your project - what will and won't be included

Your project brief must be agreed between both you and your supervisor and then submitted electronically (<https://handin.ecs.soton.ac.uk/handin/1819/COMP6200/2/> ).

Your supervisor will then confirm the suitability of your brief and provide you any feedback necessary before continuing with your project.
