Undergraduate Scholarship Scheme

- ❑ Companies offer scholarships that include:
 - ❑ Annual bursaries of £1,000
 - ❑ Paid summer (or longer) work placements
 - ❑ Equivalent annual salaries for 2012/13 were £16k-£19k
 - ❑ Some companies offer placement years as well
 - ❑ Industrial/scholar mentoring
 - ❑ Professional development/networking at Summer Workshop
 - ❑ Opportunities to build relationships with potential employers

- ❑ Scholarships
 - ❑ Can start in any year of your degree (except the final year) and continue to the end (starting this academic year)
 - ❑ Will include at least at least one work placement
 - ❑ But may include more depending on company and student

Students Eligible for Scholarships

- ❑ Permanent right to work in UK
 - ❑ UK National or EU Citizen with settled status
- ❑ ECS students doing a BEng or MEng degree in:
 - ❑ Electronic Engineering (inc. “with X/IS” degrees)
 - ❑ Electrical Engineering/Mechatronics (inc. “with IS” degrees)
 - ❑ Electrical and Electronic Engineering (inc. “with IS” degrees)
 - ❑ Biomedical/Aerospace Electronic Engineering (inc. “with IS” degrees)
- ❑ Good academic performance
 - ❑ 1st Year: Equivalent* of AAA at A-level (inc Maths)
 - ❑ >1st Year: Overall average of >60% in last academic year
- ❑ In any year of degree course, except final year
 - ❑ Can apply again, even if you were unsuccessful last year!
- ❑ Not holding another scholarship/sponsoring funded by a single commercial organisation

UK-ESF at Southampton

❑ You stand an excellent chance of getting one!

❑ Southampton has an excellent success rate:

❑ Overall (2010-2020): 30%

❑ Last year (2020): 39%

❑ Over eleven years:

❑ 541 ECS students applied

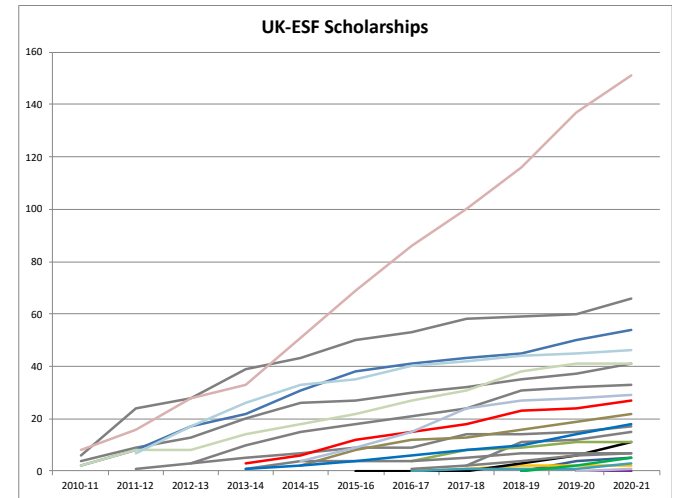
❑ 161 have been successful
